## Tourist Places Around Jabalpur



World famous Bhedaghat is situated by the side of river Narmada and is approximately 30 km from Jabalpur city. Its most famous sights are the Dhuandhar Falls, Marble Rocks etc.

Khajuraho temple is one of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites in India. The temple is famous for its nagara-style architectural symbolism and their erotic sculptures.



Jabalpur is famous for the Balancing Rock. It is amazingly that it survived even in earthquake of magnitude 6.5. It is said that it's impossible to disturb the balance of this rock.

World famous Kanha National Park and Bandhavgarh National Park are about 150 km from Jabalpur. Parks are famous for Tigers and other wild animals.



Sanchi is a Buddhist complex, famous for its Great Stupa, on a hilltop at Sanchi Town in Raisen District of Madhya Pradesh State. It is one of the oldest stone structure in India and was originally commissioned by the emperor Ashoka in the 3<sup>rd</sup> century BCE.

Chausath Yogini Temple in Bhedaghat locality, is one of the oldest heritage sites in India. It was built in the 10<sup>th</sup> Century AD by the Kalachuri kingdom.
