<u>Proceedings of the Interaction Meeting of the Executive Council, Councillors, and Editors of</u> <u>ISWS, Jabalpur, M.P.</u>

An Online meeting of the Executive Council (EC), Councillors and Editors of the Indian Society of Weed Science (ISWS) was held on 05 July 2025 at 11:00 AM.

During the meeting, the following points were discussed and several decisions/considerations were put forth for follow-up actions of those concerned:

Councillors:

- 1. Councillors will provide a responsive role in contacting the life members of the state/UT and keep them updated about the society's activities.
- 2. They will keep updating the state life members list and organize the events of their local importance/problems involving farmers, students and a few corporate personnel under the banner of ISWS.
- 3. A guideline has been framed and is available to all the councillors for submitting the proposal for organizing events (<u>https://www.isws.org.in/Guidelines_event.aspx</u>).
- 4. They may prepare leaflets/pamphlets/folders regarding weed management practices in their respective regional languages for the benefit of the farming communities under the banner of ISWS. They will enrich the document repository of ISWS.
- 5. Councillors were encouraged to write good research papers on weed management and submit to IJWS and also timely submission of reviewed manuscripts.
- 6. They should organize meetings with the industry personnel, where the kind of ongoing research, industry perspective on weed management, and their priorities will be discussed.
- 7. Councillors should encourage to make cross disciplinary membership drive for more visibilities of the society and share weed science information timely for the ISWS newsletter.
- 8. Database of Industries/personnel in their contact/ overall will be updated and sent to the ISWS office for compilation and making a comprehensive industries database of the country.

Editors:

- 1. Indian Journal of Weed Science is the mirror of the society, so its timely and quality publication is must and the Editors were requested to strictly adhere to this.
- 2. Efforts should be made to enhance the NAAS rating of IJWS and also efforts for getting impact factor journal.
- 3. Two special issues on review articles will be published in two years with recent development in weed science. The Editorial Board under the Chairmanship of Editor-in-Chief may approach to national and international weed scientists well in advance for these special issues. Suggested to share the information for ISWS newsletter for timely publication.
- 4. Requested to cooperate and timely review the manuscript.
- 5. Encourage the colleagues to cite recently published articles of IJWS in their manuscripts.
- 6. As usual, the data more than 5 years old will not be considered for publication until and unless have some scientific significance and novelty. This will be decided by the Chief Editor.
- 7. All are requested to kindly cite the published articles of IJWS in your manuscript, which are being submitted elsewhere.
